Please bring plenty of water, snacks, and lounging chairs as they will be needed, particularly for our elderly brothers and sisters. **All brothers who participate in the March are to be dressed in proper masonic regalia to include a black suit (including the jacket), white shirt and solid black tie.**

It is very important that we assemble in Selma, Alabama in mass numbers. This is an opportune time to stand in solidarity in support of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, which is currently under attack nationwide. Consider this March as a time to remember for the seasoned brother and a history lesson for the younger brother. I am counting on you to help make this another great success.
